

# Lloyd D. Landon Dies on Thursday; Funeral Sunday

FOREST —Lloyd D. Landon, 61, of Forest, died at 2:30 p. m. Thursday in San Antonio hospital after an illness of three years. He was hospitalized since Tuesday.
